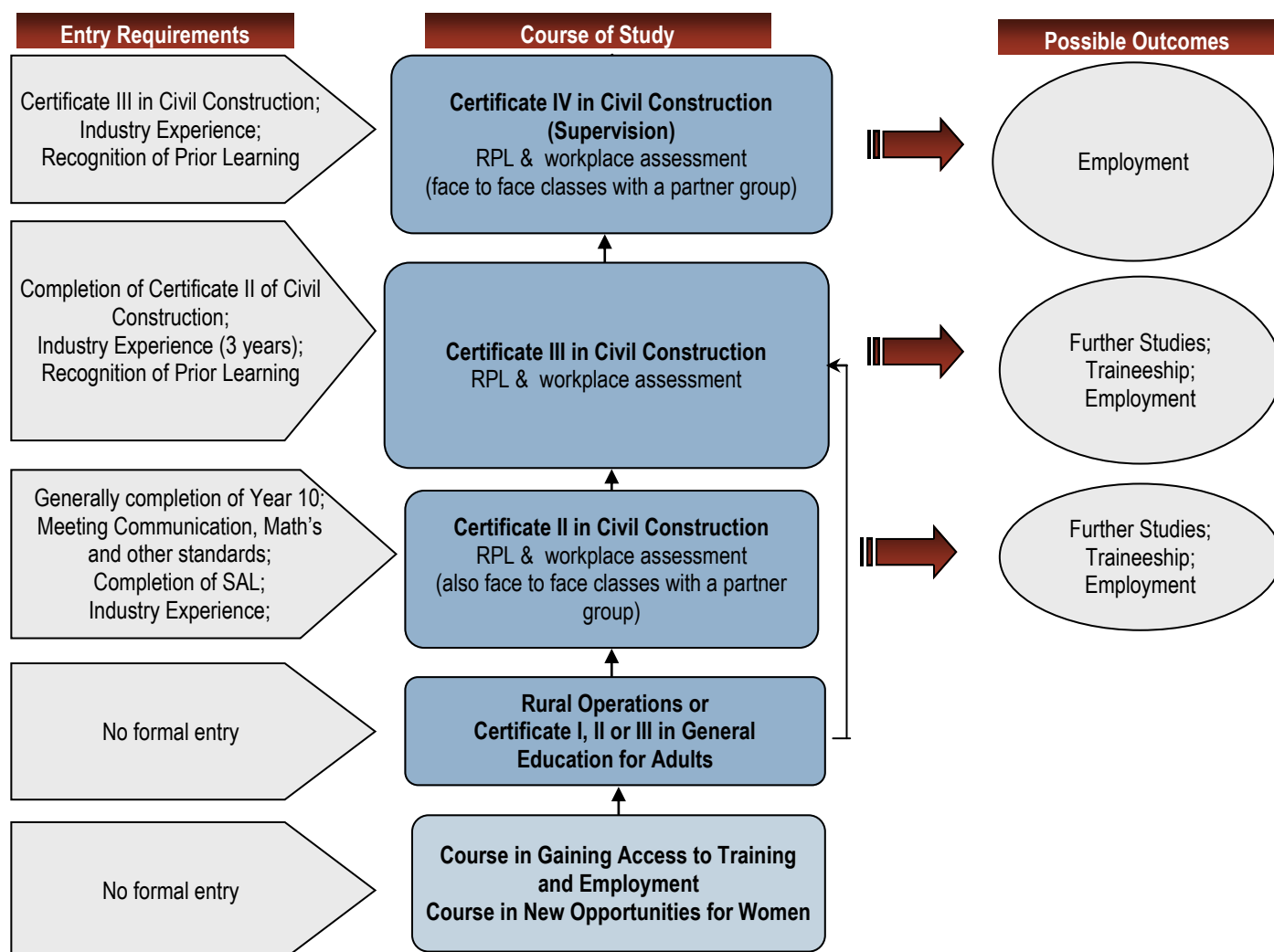


Interested in a career in the Civil Construction industry?

This qualification provides you with the practical skills and knowledge to undertake a range of manual labouring tasks and operate machinery on construction sites. You will learn to develop safe work practices, use equipment and tools and communicate in the workplace. You will also learn skills that enable you to read plans, take measurements, lay and repair concrete surfaces, drain sites, spread and compact materials manually and organise work.

The employment opportunities available within the Civil Construction industry include roles such as:
Mine workers, Plant operators, Road construction, Civil Construction (Local Government & Private Enterprises), Supervisors

What are the entrance requirements?

Entrance requirements are the lowest level of school results you need to be allowed into a full-time course at Durack Institute of Technology.

Entrance requirements will be either:

A lower level qualification, for example, to enrol in a Certificate IV in Disability Work you need a Certificate III in Disability Work

OR

Communication skills and if required math skills

The level of communication and math skills required for entry to a course will be measured according to the following scale:

- Basic skills
- Developed skills
- Well Developed skills
- Highly Developed skills
